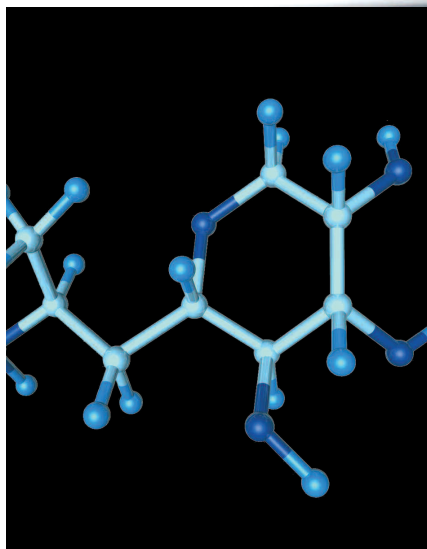
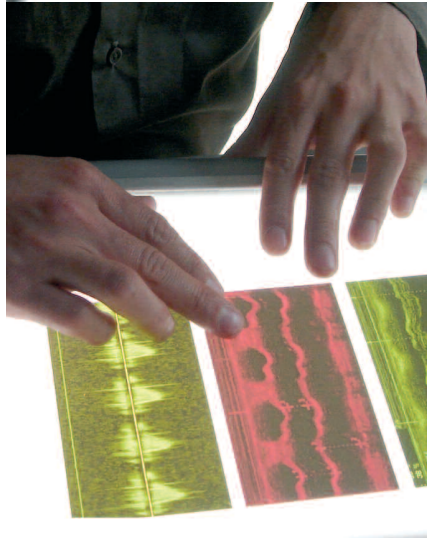
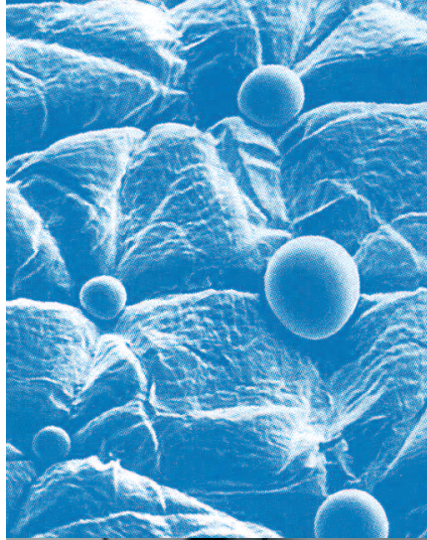

If so, we invite you to submit your project to the Scientific Committee of the La Roche-Posay Foundation.

During the European Academy of Dermato Venerology in Berlin, October 2009 under the chairmanship of Professor Bieber, (Germany), in collaboration with Professors Gelmetti (Italy) Grimalt (Spain), Haneke and Luger (Germany), Mc Grath (England), Panizzon (Switzerland), Placek (Poland), De Raeve (Belgium) Taieb and Vabres (France), The Scientific Committee will evaluate all submitted files and award:

A Research Grant of 20 000 €:

will be awarded to a research project in biological, pharmacological or clinical dermatology. To be considered, submit 3 copies of your application file in English, including:

- a detailed presentation of the project
- a summary of the project
- a financial plan
- a presentation of the medical team involved
- your CV, including a list of your publications

Two Publication Prizes of 4 000 €:

will be awarded to a research study in biological, pharmacological or clinical dermatology, which has been approved for publication or published between April 2007 and April 2009.

To be considered, submit 3 copies of your application file in English, including:

- the full article, with references of the publishing journal
- your CV, including a list of your publications
